



INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERES

This tender document contains technical bid containing the conditions of the contract and price bid containing the Bill of quantities. Tenderer shall submit the technical bids duly signed and Bill of Quantities along with Tender fees and EMD amount in physical form to the office of Regional Manager, Baroda U.P.Bank, Regional Office, Azamgarh. The technical bid and price bid shall be received up to 12.00 p.m. On 13.02.2024. Tenders will be opened at 4.00 p.m. On 13.02.2024.

1. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT AND INITIAL SECUIRITY DEPOSIT

Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only) shall be submitted in the form of demand draft on any nationalized bank in favor of "Baroda U.P. Bank, Regional Office Azamgarh and payable at Azamgarh to the office of Regional Manager, Baroda U.P. Bank, Regional Office Azamgarh. Successful contractor will have to submit initial security deposit of 2% of the contract amount including EMD before commencement of the work by way of demand draft favoring Baroda U.P. Bank, Regional Office, Azamgarh within 5 days of receipt of work order. EMD retained by bank will not bear any interest.

2. PERIOD OF VALIDITY:

The item rate contract shall remain valid for acceptance for a period of 6 months from the date of submission of tenders. If any tenderer who agree to undertake the work as per rate contract and withdraw his tender before the said period or make any modifications, in the terms and conditions of the tender, then the Employer has the liberty to forfeit the said earnest money deposit.

3. INSPECTION OF SITE:

Every tenderer is expected to inspect the site of proposed work and acquaint himself with the site conditions, approaches, availability of the raw materials, geological and weather conditions etc. before undertaking the work.

4. ALL INCLUSIVE RATES:

The contractor's rate must be firm and include the labor for fixing, erection and commissioning, cost of material, cost of transportation of materials to the site, all taxes such as sales tax, excise duty, octroi, works contract, goods service tax and any other statutory levy etc., and fixing or placing in position for which the item of work are intended to be operated. The rates quoted by the contractor shall be firm throughout the contract period and there shall be no upward revision of the rates. It should be clearly understood that any





claims for extra sales tax, excise duty, octroi, works contract and any other statutory levy etc., shall not be entertained in any case what so ever once the tenders are opened. Contractor should also take into account the probable change in the taxation after the GST regime introduced by the Central Govt/State Govt and no extra payment on account of change of duties/taxation shall be entertained once the tender is accepted. **GST as per applicable rates on the whole contract shall be paid to contractors in addition to the total amount of work which will be actually measured and paid to contractor as per the rates quoted by them.**

5. Defect liability period:

Any defect developed within the defect liability period of 12 months, will have to be rectified by the contractors ather own cost and incase, the defects are not rectified by the contractor, Employer or their representative shall get the work done at the risk and cost of the contractor.

6. Delays in commencement:

The contractor shall not be entitled to any compensation for any loss suffered by him on account of delays in commencing or executing the work, whatever the cause for such delays may be including delays in procuring government controlled or other materials.

The contractor should inspect the source of materials, their quality, quantity and availability. The material must strictly comply with the relevant specifications attached.

7. Measurement and Billing:

Whenever mode of measurement is specified, measurements will be taken at site as per latest IS Code of practice for measurement.

The contractor or his representative shall accompany the Employer or their representative/empanelled architect in taking/checking measurement. All necessary tapes shall be of steel and shall be supplied by the contractor. The contractor shall then present his bill based on the agreed and recorded measurements and if the contractor fails to accompany the Employer for measurement, then he shall be bound by the measurements taken by the Employer or their representative.

8. WATER, ELECTRICITY AND OTHER CHARGES:

The contractor shall make his own arrangements for power supply/distribution system for driving plant or machinery for the work and for lighting purpose at his own cost. The cost of running and maintenance of the plants are to be included in his tender prices. Also the contractor at his own cost shall clear the debris immediately after the completion of work.

I/We understood the conditions of the rate contract. We accept to undertake and complete the work within period and as per the specifications of the work.

STANDARD GUIDELINES FOR RCC ENCLOSURES OF SAFES FOR ALL BRANCHES

GUIDELINES

Stage 1

Construct mass concrete platform of Approx. Size W (Width of safe) x D (Depth of safe) x H (Height 6"), strictly as per specifications.

Stage 2

After allowing this mass concrete platform to dry out for 24 to 48 hours, (allow for normal watering/curing). Keep the safe over it.

Stage3

Construct 2 Nos. RCC side walls, 1 No. RCC Rear wall and No. RCC slab in such a way that Safe gets completely embedded in this enclosure. i.e. there should not be any gap between Safe, RCC Walls & Slabs. After allowing for normal period of 2 days for curing, setting, watering etc. remove shuttering & plaster the visible Facades of RCC walls & slabs as per specifications.

SPECIFICATIONS

- Provide materials for 1:2:4 CC & construct mass concrete platform of Size W
 (Width of safe) x D (Depth of safe) x H (Height 6"), for keeping safe over it.
- Provide materials for 1:2:4 CC and construct 2 nos 4" thick RCC side walls, 1 no. 4" thick RCC rear wall and 1 no. 4" thick RCC top slab including reinforcement dia 12 mm M S bars@ 4" center to center both ways(M S bars to be placed at center of RCC walls and slabs), including 12 mm thick external plaster(C M 1:4) in Neeru finish & 3 Coats of white wash.
